

Integrated Care Board: Supplementary NENC variations



Striking Variations within NENC





For diabetic admissions to hospital there is very high variation in rates per diabetic. The highest areas of North & South Tyneside, Hartlepool, and Stockton have rates of 203-211 admissions per 10k diabetics. Whereas the lowest areas Darlington and County Durham have rates half the highest at 87-91 per 10k diabetics.



In **stage 1 bowel cancer** diagnosis **North Tyneside** (25.8% of diagnoses) is **much higher** than the next best County Durham (17.9% of diagnoses). It has **twice the proportion of North Cumbria** (12.0% of diagnoses) the **worst performing**, which does have a **third** (33.6%) with a **missing** diagnosis stage.



In the past five years in referrals to **Mental Health** Services for people **aged 0-18** years **Sunderland** and **South Tyneside** had a referral rates of **128** and **124** per **1,000**. On the North bank **North Tyneside** and **Newcastle Gateshead** were much lower at **90** and **73** per **1,000**.

NENC vs England "Doing Better"

Many of the questions leverage data from sources only available in NENC therefore comparable data at a national level isn't necessarily available, where it is accessible it has been used. For the relevant parts of this report these have been clearly marked.





For NENC measles, mumps, & rubella (MMR) vaccinations 96.4% had a first dose 92.1% had both doses aged 5 years. This is better than the national uptake of 93.5% first dose and 85.7% second dose.



In **breast cancer screening** in women aged 53-70 the uptake in **NENC** was 67.8% compared to overall **England** uptake of 64.9%.




In the seven **CQC** patient experience surveys published since 2020 only one result for one trust was worse than the nationally expected values, and **7** results were better than expected.



For knee replacement surgeries three NENC providers had significantly better health gains than the England average. These were North Tees & Hartlepool FT, Northumbria FT, and Nuffield Tees. No providers were significantly worse



NENC vs England "Doing Worse"



People **not** living in the top 50 **most deprived** MSOAs in NENC (F 82.4 / M 78.6) are still expected to **live a year less** than people in **England** overall (F 83.2 / M 79.5)

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
