Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request for Information - NHS North East and North **Cumbria Integrated Care Board (NENC ICB)**

Thank you for your request received by North of England Commissioning Support (NECS) on 29 November 2024 for information held by NHS North East and North Cumbria Integrated Care Board (the ICB) under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The ICB covers the areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside, Sunderland, and Tees Valley (which covers the five local authorities of Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar and Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees).

Please find the information you requested on behalf of the ICB as follows.

Your Request

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding memory, ADHD and ASD assessments managed by your ICB. I would be grateful if you could provide the following information:

Memory Assessments

- 1. Do you deliver or partner with private companies to help deliver memory assessments?
- 2. What is the current split of assessments that are completed virtually vs in person?
- 3. Which private providers are you currently working with for FY 2024/25?
- 4. Which private providers did you work with FY 2023/24?
- 5. What was the spend on Memory assessments in FY 2023/24?
- 6. What was the spend on Memory assessments FY 2022/23?
- 7. What is the price for an individual assessment?

- 1. Assessment
- 2. Titration

Our Response

We can confirm, as per Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the ICB holds some of the information you have requested.

Memory Assessments

NENC ICB does not deliver or partner with private companies to help deliver memory assessments. No, memory assessments are delivered by Tees, Esk and Wear Valleys NHS Foundation Trust under a block contract across County Durham and Tees Valley.

Cumbria, Northumberland, Tyne and Wear NHS Foundation Trust provide this service under a block contract to North Cumbria, North Tyneside, Northumberland, Newcastle, Gateshead, South Tyneside and Sunderland.

ADHD and ASD

For ADHD and ASD, NENC ICB does not hold any contracts with non-NHS providers.

Where non-NHS providers hold a contract with another ICB in England or NHS England, Right to Choose may apply, depending on the service specification and contract terms. In those cases, NENC ICB would be charged for patient activity under other ICB contracts, providing the referral route was in line with Right to Choose Criteria and assessment/treatment was delivered in line with the NHS Standard Contract in place between the alternative ICB and provider.
